

Take your leadership to the next level by becoming an *Advanced PRME Signatory*

PRME is a voluntary initiative, open to all degree-granting and publicly-accredited institutions of higher education. Our global community of signatories help transform business and management education, work to develop the responsible leaders of the future, and realise the Sustainable Development Goals through responsible management education.

Signatories to PRME fall into two categories: **Basic** and **Advanced**.

Basic PRME Signatories report regularly through the Sharing Information on Progress (SIP) report every 24 months, but have limited access to peer-learning, communication and leadership opportunities.

Advanced PRME Signatories also comply with the SIP report policy, as well as make a nominal contribution to the **Annual Service Fee**.

By contributing annually, institutions unlock exciting engagement opportunities and access to unique leadership platforms that amplify their impact on the PRME community and showcase achievements to global audiences.

Use of the PRME Logo

Participation in PRME highlights your institution's commitment to responsible management education, sustainability and ethics. The UN Global Compact and United Nations hold a variety of meetings and events around the world, often welcoming academia. Invitations are sent to Advanced PRME Signatories before other institutions, and sometimes include speaking opportunities.

Chair a PRME Chapter or PRME Working Group

PRME networks – Chapters and Working Groups – are opportunities for peer learning, dialogue facilitation, research collaboration, and the development of exciting new projects that support responsible management education. Chairs of these networks must be from an Advanced PRME Signatory.

Access the PRME SDG Student Engagement Platform

Experiential learning is an important way to educate the responsible leaders of the future. Students from Advanced PRME signatories can access the projects on the Student Engagement Platform, allowing them unique insight and learning opportunities with companies in the UN Global Compact.

Host a PRME Regional Meeting

PRME's 15 Regional Chapters hold meetings and events regularly to connect local signatories, UN Global Compact businesses, and other stakeholders. Hosts of these meetings gain visibility and exposure, and can showcase their unique accomplishments and initiatives to participants.

Discounted registration to the PRME Global Forum

Held every two years, the PRME Global Forum is the largest gathering of faculty, deans and thought leaders in the responsible management education landscape. It helps position the PRME community as the most impactful global movement advancing values of sustainability and ethics in higher education, and sets the agenda for the initiative's future goals and projects.

Priority internships

Internship opportunities at PRME and the UN Global Compact are available twice a year, and allow students unique insights into our work and engagement with the United Nations. Applicants from Advanced PRME Signatories are given preferred access to these opportunities.
